Come explore the Gospel of John, **Enjoy a meal and conversation-Everyone's Welcome**

Our weekly newsletter keeps you updated and connected with MCC. God has been doing some great things in the lives of so many people and we are excited for where He is leading us in 2024.

At 10am Pastor Stephen Scott will speak The Word on the Gospel of John 3:1-21. Then at 6pm we have 'Meet Jesus' Café Church sessions. The purpose of 'Meet Jesus' is that all of us would encounter a living Jesus through the words of the bible. Invite someone along to join you at your table.

Last Sunday night's Meet Jesus at Café Church—pick up your copy of the reading and do the 5Rs with a friend Retell, Reveal, React, Reason and Respond

Session 1. Why should I trust John to help me know God? Does God exist? And if so, how can I know Him? These are old, universal and essential questions for us all. And they're questions John answers for us in his Gospel. For a start, while we can't see God with our eyes, God has taken the initiative to make himself known - most clearly and beautifully in the person of Jesus, the eternal Son of God.

Prayer makes a difference. God's power is seen when His people join together in prayer for one another. God hears the prayers of His people and He has the power to work mightily in any given situation.


